Whereupon the said William West present here in Court in his proper person is at the request of the afo John Burnell by his Attorney afo: Comitted into the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to Remain untill the said John of his Damages, and costs and Charges afo: should be fully Satisfied the said then to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent. present here in Court took Charge of the said W^m West accordingly &c.

William Gray } and was given to the Just. of Somerset County that he should take William Gray late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his Bailly, wife and him should safekeep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek in the County afo: the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto John Hoovington of a plea of tres pass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c.

And the afo John Hoovington by Francis Allen his attorney Complains against the said William Gray in the plea afo as followeth &c.

Somerset County p. William Gray late of Ripney parish in Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto John Hoovington of a plea of tres pass upon the Case &c. And whereupon the said John by Francis Allen his attorney Complains that whereas the said W^m the first day of February and Dow. One thousand Two hundred and thirty two at Somerset County afo: within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Judged unto the said John in Eighteen hundred pounds of Tob.^o and three Skill Curr. Money of Maryland for sundry properly chargeable in Acc^t as by Acc^t. herunto Annexed may in Court appear And being so thereof Judged the said William in Consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the place afores. upon himself did Assume and to the said John then and there did faithfully promise that he the said William the said Eighteen hundred pounds of Tob.^o and three Skill Curr. Money to the said John when he should be therunto Requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content Nevertheless the said William his promise and Assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid Made Nothing Regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the said John in that part Craftily and Subtly to Deceive and defraud the said Eighteen hundred pounds of Tob.^o and three Skill Curr. Money to the said John altho the same to do the said William by the said John on the aforesaid first day of Feb^y in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at Somerset County afores. within the Jurisdiction aforesaid he was therunto Requested hath not paid or taken for the same in any sort Contented but the same to him hitherto to pay or Content
