One thousand seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships the Lord Proprietarys County Court of Somerset now hold at dividing Beck in and the County afo came the said Ambrose Riggini in his proper person and being Justly demanded how he would acquitt himself of the premises afo above upon him Imposed Oath that he w^{ld} not plead with his said Lord but submit with a protestation of his Innocency and put himself upon the favour of the Court &c. whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood.
