His Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietary Commander  
in Chief of the State of Somerset County by his writ in these words following  
vid. Somerset vs. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the  
Provinces of Maryland Avalon Lord Barron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher of Somerset  
County Greeting Whereas James Timmons and Aaron Timmons Lets of Somerset County  
planters lately in our County Court of Somerset here (to witt) the seventeenth day of  
August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty one before said Hopkins  
Govt and his Associates then our Justices of our same Court at Dividing Creek in the  
County aforesaid. Appeared Upon themselves, and Undertook and Each of them Undertook  
for a certain William Shipham late of Somerset County Planter the said William  
Shipham of Accomack County in the Colony of Virginia that in Case a certain Joseph  
Jones should Recover Judgment against the said William Shipham in a plea of Debt  
for one hundred pounds Curr: money of this province, by the said Joseph against  
the said William in the said Court prosecuted or that the said William should be  
therein convicted, that then the said William to the said Joseph, the Debt aforesaid, as also  
the Damages which to him the said Joseph by occasion of the Detaining of that same  
Debt in any Manner to him to be adjudged he should pay and satisfy or that  
the said William his Body in Execution of such Judgment to the Sher of said County  
should Render or that they the said James Timmons and Aaron Timmons would  
do the same for him as by the Record and proceeding thereupon in our said Court, before  
our Justices Remaining Manifestly Appareth. And Altho. the said Joseph  
Afterwards (to witt) the fifteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and  
thirty two before Rob: King Govt and his Associates then our Justices of the  
said Court at Dividing Creek afo. by consideration of our said Court Recovered  
against the said William the said one hundred pounds Curr: money his Debt afo., as  
also five hundred and fifty seven pounds of Tob: for his Damages sustained by occasion  
of the Detaining of the said Debt whereof he is convicted, as by the Record and  
proofs thereof, in our said Court before our Justices at Dividing Creek afo. Likewise  
Remaining manifestly Appareth. Nevertheless the said William his Body in Execution  
of the Judgment aforesaid to the Sher of Somerset County afo. hath not Rendered  
nor the said William the aforesaid Joseph of the Debt and Damages afo.  
hath not satisfied as by the Jurisdiction of the said Joseph we have recd  
and because We are willing that those things which in our said Court
