The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had wherefore it is Considered by the Court here that a Commission Issue to the said Henry Dorman as by the petition aforesaid is prayed, and that James Strawbridge, Wm Jones manorian John Finch and Thomas Brown of Somerset County Jents. be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided &c.
