According to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons In whose hand you make the Same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before Our Justices of our County Court to be held as afo. to shew cause if any he she or they have why the Same Goods Chattles Right or Credits so Attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof lead and Made (According to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided) if to him her or them It shall seem Meet & how you shall Execute this Writ that you make known unto Our Said Justices at the Day and place afo. and have you there and there this Writ Witness Robert King Gent Chief Justice of our Said Court the Twentyninth Day of November In the Nineteenth Year of our Dominion &c. And Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Three - At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the Same Month and Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Three being the Day of the Return of the Said Writ Cometh the Said John Dennis Ind by Francis Allen ^{his attorney} and the Sher of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was Directed Likewise Comes and Makes Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed By Vertue of the Within Writ to me Directed to the Justices of Somerset County I do Certifie that on the Second Day of March One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Three I did Attach of the Goods and Chattles of y^e within Named Samuel McCall John Blackburn & John Allen Merchants to the Value of two pounds ten shillings and six pence ^{money} and five hundred pounds of Tobacco in y^e hand of Mr. James Martin and for the Use of Mr. John Dennis Ind and I do further Certifie that before John Doe & Richard Roe Good and Lawfull men of My Bailiwick I have made known to the aforesd James Martin that he be and appear at the time and place appointed to answer

Whereupon the afo James Martin Garnishe of the afo Samuel McCall, John Blackburn and John Allen altho. solemnly Called Comes nor shews Cause why &c. but made default

Thereupon the said John Dennis Ind. by his attorney afo prays that Upon giving Security according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided the afo sum of fifty shillings and six pence ^{money} and five hundred pounds of Tobacco so as afo attached in the hands of the afo James Martin as of the Rights and Credits of the afo Samuel McCall, John Blackburn and John Allen may be condemned in the hands of the said James Martin towards satisfying unto him the said John Dennis his Damages, and Costs and Charges Sustained by means of afo Suit &c.

Whereupon a Certain Joshua Merrill of Somerset County Gent present therein Cometh in his proper person undertakes for the said John Dennis Ind. according to act of assembly that if in Case
