All which said Next Court to witt the twentieth Day of November And Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the afo James Lindow as the afo Robert Deuiston by their Attorneys afo and whereupon the said Robert prays further Seave thereof to Jugarle hereuntill Next Court and he hath it and the same Day is given to the afo James herealso &c.

All which said Next Court to witt the Nineteenth Day of March And Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the afo James Lindow as the afo Robert Deuiston by their Attorneys afo and whereupon the said Robert as before Defends the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he Did not assume upon himself in Manner and form as the said James above against him hath Complained & thereof he puts himself upon the Countrey &c. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the afo James Lindow take nothing by his witt and declaration on afo but be in mercy for his false clamour and that the said Robert Deuiston go thereof without day &c. and further it is Considered that the afo Robert Deuiston Recover against the afo James Lindow five hundred & seventy two pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his defence in that part Sustained to the same Robert by the Court here according to the form of the Statute in such Case lately made and provided adjudged and that the same debt have thes of Bouillon &c.
