Court before our Justices are Rightfully Acted, and Acknowledged, Ought to be duly Executed, - We Command you that by honest and Lawfull men of Your County of Ballywick you make known unto the afo. James Timmons and Aaron Timmons that they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Crook the Third Tuesday of June next, to show Cause if any thing for themselves they have or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid Joseph his Execution of the Judgment aforesaid Against them according to the form of the Recovery aforesaid Ought not to have if to them it shall seem Expedient and have you then and there the Names of them before whom to them you make the same known and this writ Witness Robt King Esq. Chief Justice of our said Court the Twentyfourth Day of April in the Eighteenth Year of our Dom. Gt. Anno Dom. one thousand seven hundred and thirty three

At which said Third Tuesday of June - With the Nineteenth day of the same Month Anno Dom. one thousand seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset hold at Dividing Crook in the County afo. came the aforesaid Joseph Jones by Francis Allon his Attorney and the Sher of Somerset County to wit Joshua Caldwell Esq. at the same day Returned that he by Virtue of the Writ afo. to him Directed had made known unto the aforesaid James Timmons by Joshua Merrill and John Doe honest and Lawfull men of his Ballywick that he be and appear before his said Lordships Justices at the day and place afo. to show C. as within to him it was Comanded and the afo. James Timmons so forwarned and at the same Day being solemnly Called Cometh not but Makes Default - Therefore it is Considered that the afo. Joseph Jones have Execution against the same James Timmons of the Debt and Damages afo. according to the form of the Recognizance afo. &c.
