The said Hutton Hill present here in Court in his proper person at the prayer of the aft Ambros Willett by his attorney aft is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action aft thereupon a certain John Owen of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertakes for the said Hutton Hill and did assure upon himself that if in Case the said Ambros Willett should recover Judgment against the said Hutton Hill in the plea aft or that the said Hutton should be therein Convict that then he the said Hutton Hill should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or Render his body to the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said John Owen will do the same for him &c.

One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the aft Ambros Willett as the aft Hutton Hill by their attorneys aft and whereupon the aft Hutton prays further Leave thereof to Dispute hereuntole next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aft Ambros here also &c.

At which said next Court to witt the nineteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the aft Ambros Willett as the aft Hutton Hill by their attorneys aft and whereupon the same Hutton as before defends the force and Injury whereof and saith that he did not assure upon himself in manner and form as the said Ambros above
