At which ſaid next Court to witt the nineteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came again as wele the afo^r Ambroſe Willett as the afo^r Hutton Hile by their attorneys afo^r and whereupon the ſame Hutton as before defendant the fore and Injury wherefore and ſaith that he did not abne upon himſelf in manner and form as the ſaid Ambroſe above ag.
