 Mills, Thomas Rayly Wm Holland and John Fleming who to say the truth of the premises being
 duly elected tried and sworn upon their Oath did say that the said Hutton Hill did assume upon him-
 self in such manner and form as the said Ambros Willett above against him hath complained and asse-
 sed the damage of the same Ambros beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part
 appoyed to three pounds ten shillings Curr^t money of Maryland and for those Costs and Charges
 to one pound of Tobacco. Whereupon the said Hutton Hill pray, the Court here that
 according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that they would dissolve themselves
 into a Court of Chancery and give Judgment in the premises according to the rules in Equity &c.
 afterwards in the same Court came the said Hutton Hill and say, that he cannot gain say but
 that the said Ambros Willett should recover against him ^{for} the said three pounds ten shillings Curr^t money
 and one pound of Tobacco the damages as by the Jurors as aforesaid and not more and because the
 said Ambros deny's not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true, pray's Judgment for those
 damages as together with his Costs and Charges as ^{by} ad judged &c.

Therefore by consent of the parties it is considered that the said Ambros Willett recover
 against the said Hutton Hill his damages as to three pounds ten shillings Curr^t money and one pound
 of Tobacco ^{and} in form as aforesaid as also two thousand two hundred forty six ^{pounds}
 of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges as to the same Ambros by the Court here of his assent as judged &c.
 the said debt in mery &c.
