 Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause
 to come here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now in Court sitting at
 Bridgwater in the County of twelve & by whom he and who neither & because as well & and afterwards
 Immediately came here of the Jury & and the Jurores of that same Jury by Joshua Caldwell Gent
 Sheriff of the County & to this impanelled being called came to wit Edward Beacham Esq[ue]r Sheriff
 Thomas Dison, George Full, Littleton Townsend Robert Mitchell, Joshua Slingsby, George Weston Willm
 Mills, Thomas Rely Wm Holland and John Flemming who to say the truth of the premises being
 duly sworn byed and sworn upon their Oath did say that the afo[rd] Hutton Hille did affaine upon him
 selfe in such manner and form as the afo[rd] Ambrof Willett above against him hath complained and affa-
 ined the damage of the same Ambrof borrowed his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part
 apponered to three pounds ten shillings curr[money] of Maryland and for those Costs and Charges
 to one pound of tobacco -- Whereupon the afo[rd] Hutton Hille prayeth the Court here that
 according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that they would dissolve themselves
 into a court of Chancery and give judgment in this premises afo[rd] according to the rules in Equity &
 afterwards in the same Court cause the said Hutton Hille and say that he cannot satisfy but
 that the said Ambrof Willett should recover against him the afo[rd] three pounds ten shillings curr[money]
 and one pound of tobacco the damages afo[rd] by the Court afo[rd] assessed and not more and because the
 afo[rd] Ambrof denys not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true, prayeth Judgment for these
 damages afo[rd] together with his Costs and Charges afo[rd] adjudged &

Therefore by consent of the parties afo[rd] it is considered that the afo[rd] Ambrof Willett recover
 against the afo[rd] Hutton Hille his damage afo[rd] to three pounds ten shillings curr[money] and one pound
 of tobacco afo[rd] informed and confessed as also Two thousand two hundred and forty Six — pounds
 of tobacco for his Costs and Charges afo[rd] to the same Ambrof by the Court here of his afo[rd] adjudged &
 the afo[rd] Debts in money &c.

At WOB Saul Townsend of Somerset by Thomas Kellsick Late of Somerset County Painter was attested

to R H Thomas Kellsick to answer unto Saul Townsend of a plea of trespass upon the case &c.

And whereupon the same Paul by Francis Allen his attorney complains that where
