

Baltimore To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Thomas Boorman late of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of One thousand pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before Our Justices of Our County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Court the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of Albertam Charles Ramsey unless the said Thomas Boorman by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Charles Ramsey in plea of trespass upon the fact according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before Our Justices of Our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto Our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you there and there this writ with Wittness Robert King Esq. Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty ninth day of November in the nineteenth Year of our Dominion Br. One thousand seven hundred & thirty three

At which said third Tuesday of March to with the nineteenth day of the Same month and Year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh the said Charles Ramsey by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed and made return thereof to the Court here before in these words following viz

By Verbe of the within writ to me directed to the Justice of Somerset County I do Certifie that on the fourth day of February One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three I did attach of the goods and Chattels of the within named Thomas Boorman to the value of One thousand pounds of Tobacco in the hands of William Houston and Peter Berkett and William Jones and I do further Certifie that before Joshua Morris and Henry Jorman good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I have made known unto the aforesaid Wm Houston Peter Berkett and William Jones that they be and appear at the time and place within contained so answers

Whereupon the aforesaid William Houston Peter Berkett and William Jones garnishes of the aforesaid Thomas Boorman altho' solemnly called Cometh and not nor shows Cause why he but makes default

Whereupon the said Charles Ramsey by his attorney prays that upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case made and provided the aforesaid sum of One thousand pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached in the hands of the aforesaid William Houston Berkett and William Jones as of the Rights and Credits of the aforesaid Thomas Boorman may be condemned in the hands of the said William Houston Peter Berkett and William Jones

Thereupon Albertam John Danni Esq. of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertakes for the said Charles Ramsey that if in case the said Thomas Boorman do advantage himselfe in any manner and do any appearance and make all or any part of the said Charles Ramsey claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be made before the Laying of the attachment aforesaid that then he the said
