Whereupon the afo Thomas Hayward prayeth upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case provided the afo Several Joyner Tools of the value of four hundred and eighty nine pounds of tobacco as of attached as of the goods and chattels of the said Jacobus Arabia May be condemned towards satisfying unto him his damages and all costs and charges accruing by means of the attachment afo

Thereupon a certain Robert Jenkins Harry late of Somerset County Gentleman present here in full undertaken for the said Thomas Hayward according to act of assembly that if in case the said Jacobus Arabia do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Thomas Hayward claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be made undue before his laying of the attachment afo that then he the said Thomas Hayward shall make Restitution unto him the said Jacobus Arabia of all or such part thereof as shall be so made appear to be undue as afo and that he the said Robert Jenkins Harry will do it for him afo

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the Several Joyner tools so aforesaid attached of the value of four hundred and eighty nine pounds of tobacco be condemned as of the goods and chattels of the afo Jacobus Arabia towards satisfying unto the said Thomas Hayward his damages and all costs and charges accruing upon the writ of attachment afo and that the said Thomas Hayward have thereof judgment afo
