And Altho the Aforesaid William and Thomas afterwards (to witt) the fiftenth day of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty two before Rob: King Gent and his Associates then our Justices, of the same Court at Diving <sup>brook</sup> aforesaid by Consideration of the same Court Recovered Against the aforesaid Patrick two pound twelve Shill and seven pence half penny sure Money and Two hundred and Ninety five pounds of Tob: for their Damages, which they Sustained by Occasion of a certain Promise and Assumption aforesaid: William and Thomas Late by and not performed as for their Costs and Charges by them about their Suit in that part Expended whereof the said Patrick is found as by the Records and process thereof in our Same Court before our Justices at Diving brook aforesaid Likewise Remaining Manifestly Appareth Nevertheless the aforesaid Patrick his Body in Execution of the Judgment aforesaid to the Sher of the County aforesaid hath not Rendered nor the said Patrick the aforesaid William and Thomas the Damages and Costs and Charges aforesaid hath not satisfied as by the Insinuation of the said William and Thomas we have Received and because we are Willing that those things which in our Same Court before our Justices are Rightfully done and Acknowledged Ought to be duly Executed We Command you that by Honest and Lawfull men of your Balywick you make known unto the Aforesaid Dorman Heath that he be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at Diving brook in the County aforesaid the Third Tuesday of June next to show Cause if anything for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid William and Thomas their Execution of the Judgment aforesaid according to the form of the Recognizance aforesaid Ought not to have if to him it shall Expedient and have you then and there the Names of them before Whom to him you make the Same known and this Writt Wilt not Rob: King Gent Chief Justice of our Said Court the twenty fourth Day of April in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion Et Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three
