Ordered that Soukey Whittington be Overseer of the Road from Napeongo Bridge to Lodowicks Tavernough

Ordered that John Webb be Overseer of the Road from Coromoke ferry half way the Canway, and from the high Land at the upper End of the Canway to Littletons bridge, and from the said Canway to Benstons dams, and from Smith Mill's to John Merrills mill from thence to the End Canway at Coromoke &c

Ordered that Richard Hickman should be overseer of the Road from Birch Branch to the Road of Pepper Creek &c

Ordered that Ed Robert King be Overseer of the Roads from Rankone point to Kings Mill and from thence up Trading Branch on the northernmost side thereof to the row bridge over the said Branch & from thence thro' the bear Swamp to a tree dividing from Joan Conon and from Kings Mill up the Southernmost side of the said trading branch until it intersects the Road that goes thro' the bear Swamp and from his own gate & a tree standing at the northernmost End of the Long Canway dividing it from Nicholas frontun &c

And whereupon the said John by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney complains that Whereas the aforesaid Hugh in his Life Time (to witt) the Twenty sixth Day of March in the Year of Our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty at Somerset County aforesaid and Within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the said John in the Sum of Thirty Two pounds five Shillings and Six pence (and money of Maryland and the quantity of One thousand two hundred eighty five and a half pounds of Tobacco for divers goods wares and Merchants) and as by an and. here annexed into Court brought may appear and so being thereof Indebted the said Hugh in his Life time afterwards (to witt) the day and year afo at the place afo within the Jurisdiction afo in Consideration thereof upon himself did assume and to the said John then and there faithfully promise that he the said Hugh the aforesaid Thirty Two pounds five Shillings and Six pence and One thousand Two hundred eighty five and a half pounds of Tobacco aforesaid unto the said John when he should be thereunto afterwards requested Would Well and faithfully pay and Content and Altho' the said Hugh in his Life Time Seventeen pounds eight Shillings part of the said Thirty Two pounds five Shillings and Six pence to the said John he paid and Satisfied yet as Fourteen pounds Seventeen Shillings and Six pence residue thereof and the said Quantity of One thousand Two hundred eighty five and a half
