One thousand seven hundred and thirty three came againe as well the s<sup>d</sup> John Tunstall as the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Porter by their attorney s<sup>d</sup> and whereupon the said Mary prays further Leave thereof to Imparte hereuntoe next Court and she hath it and the same day is given to the s<sup>d</sup> John here also &c

All which said next Court to witt the nineteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and thirty three came againe as well the s<sup>d</sup> John Tunstall as the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Porter by their attorney s<sup>d</sup> and whereupon the same Mary as before deend. the force and injury wherof and with that the s<sup>d</sup> John his action of thereupon against her to have and maintain ought not because she saith that she the said Mary hath fully administered all the goods and Chattells which were of the s<sup>d</sup> Hugh at the time of his death in her hands to be administered and that she hath not any of the goods and Chattells of the s<sup>d</sup> Hugh in her hands to be administered nor had at the day of the Impetration of the Originall witt of the s<sup>d</sup> John nor at any time afterwards and this she is ready to verify whereupon she prays Judgment if the said John his action of thereupon to have and maintain ought &c Whereupon the s<sup>d</sup> Mary by her attorney Relinquisheth her Verification of by her above alledged and says that she cannot have say the action of of the s<sup>d</sup> John nor can she say but that the s<sup>d</sup> Hugh in his Lifetime did s<sup>d</sup> upon himselfe in manner and form as the s<sup>d</sup> John above against her hath complained and as to the damage of the same John by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Mary saith and Confesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> John has Sustained Damages by occasion of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to the s<sup>d</sup> fourteen pounds Seventeen shillings and six pence Curr. money and twelve hundred and eighty five and a halfe pounds of tobacco not more to be Levied off the goods and Chattells of the s<sup>d</sup> Hugh when ever the same shall come to the hands of the s<sup>d</sup> Mary to be administered on. and because the s<sup>d</sup> John deuy. not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges of to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties s<sup>d</sup> it is Considered that the s<sup>d</sup> ~~John Tunstall~~ John Tunstall recover against the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Porter Countre of the same Hugh Porter his damages of to the s<sup>d</sup> fourteen pounds Seventeen shillings and six pence Curr. money of Maryland & twelve hundred eighty five and a halfe pounds of tobacco ~~in form of~~ Confessed as also three hundred and seventy pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges of to the same John by the Court here and Consent of the parties s<sup>d</sup> adjudged to be Levied of the goods and Chattells which were of the s<sup>d</sup> Hugh Porter at the time of his death and which to the hands of the said Mary Countre as s<sup>d</sup> hereafter shall happen to come to be administered of the s<sup>d</sup> deff. in Maryland &c
