Sepi Corpus p. Jos Caldwell Jhd. -

Whereupon the said Patrick Burke in his own proper person appears here in Court and thereupon the said Patrick Burke at the prayer of the afo Dorman Heath by his attorney afo is adjudged to give special bail to the action afo But for want thereof the said Patrick Burke is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remain &c. His said Sheriff to wit Joshua Caldwell hath present here in Court took charge of the said Patrick accordingly &c.

At which said next Court to wit the nineteenth day of March and one thousand seven hundred and thirty three came against the said Dorman Heath by his attorney afo as the said Patrick Burke in his own proper person in Custody as afo, and thereupon a certain William Holland of Somerset County Gent present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Patrick Burke and assumed upon himself that if in favor the said Dorman Heath should recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said Patrick Burke or that the said Patrick Burke should be theron convicted that then he the said Patrick Burke should pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he said William Holland will do the same for him &c.

And because the afo Dorman Heath did not declare against the afo Patrick Burke nor prosecute his writ in the plea afo. Therefore here and his pledges of prosecuting be in mercy, and the plaintiff name Burke recover against the afo Dorman Heath his damages by omission of the premises to one hundred pounds of tobacco to the said Patrick by direction of the Justice here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute lately made and provided as judged &c.
