comes and makes return thereof to the Court here endorsed viz. Capi Corpus p. J. Caldwell Jno.

Whereupon the said Patrick Burke in his own proper person appears here in Court and thereupon the
said Patrick Burke at the prayer of the aforesaid Dorman Heath by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give specialle
bail to the action aforesaid But for want thereof the said Patrick Burke is committed into the custody of
