Ordered that Aaron Lynn pay or cause to be paid unto Daniel Boyce ninety pounds of tobacco being Due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalfe of the said Aaron Lynn against the said John Hooffington he having made Oath to the Saide &

Thomas Smith appears according to his Recognizance for the good behaviour and is discharged therefrom
