Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came againe as well the ^{and} Alexander Draper as the ^{and} Andrew Rathbone by their attorney ^{and} and whereupon the ^{and} Alexander praye that the ^{and} Andrew to his declaration ^{and} may answer, and the said Andrew altho' at the same day solemnly ^{by} ^{called} ^{by} ^{some} ^{not}, nor nothing says in Bar or preclusion of the action ^{of} the ^{and} Alexander by which the same Alexander remaineth thereof against the same Andrew undefended &c. —

Wherefore the ^{and} Alexander his damages, ^{by} ^{occasion} ^{of} ^{the} ^{premise}, against the ^{and} Andrew ought to Recover but because it is not know to his Lordships Justices here what damage the ^{and} Alexander in part hath Sustained thereupon it is Comanded the Justices of Somerset that by the oath of honest and Lawfull men of this Bailiwick he should diligently Enquire what damage the ^{and} Alexander hath Sustained as well by ^{occasion} of the Non performance of the promise and assumption ^{and} as for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed and that Inquisition which thereupon he makes he make appear to the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek in this County ^{and} the third Wednesday of March next under his Seal and the Seals of them by whose oath he takes that same Inquisition he send together with the writ therof to him directed and the same day is given to the ^{and} Andrew therof also &c. at which said next Court to wit the nineteenth day of March and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices then of at Dividing Creek Cometh the ^{and} Alexander Draper by his attorney ^{and} and the Justices of Somerset County send not therof his writ.

Robert Harris } Robert Harris appears according to a certain Recognizance entered into for his appearance
Recognizance } at this Court to answer an Information for the Importation of negro's into this Province
and entering of them ^{and} and paying the duties according to Law &c. thereupon the said Robert
Harris is discharged from the same Recognizance &c. and ordered to give new Recognizance for his appearance
at August Court next to answer an ^{and} &c. whereupon the said Robert Harris present here in Court
acknowledged himselfe to owe to his Lordship forty pounds Sterling to Levied &c. If it happen that
he does not appear before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing
Creek the third Wednesday of August next to answer an ^{and} &c. afterwards for reasons to his Lordships
Justices here of said Robert Harris is immediately discharged from the Recognizance ^{and} &c. —
