Wherefore it is considered by the Judges here that the said John McClester the petitioner be and remain as Guardian to the said Adam Carlyle and John Carlyle Orphans as aforesaid until they shall arrive at full age for the choosing of their Guardian &c. Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that Thos. Nuttall of Somerset County deliver up unto the said John McClester Guardian as aforesaid ~~the estate of~~ the said Adam Carlyle and John Carlyle <sup>with all their estate</sup> that he hath in his hands and possession both lease and personale, and that the said Guardian receive the same &c. —

And further it is ordered by the Court here that the said John McClester give security for to comply with the Guardianship aforesaid. —

Whereupon the said John McClester together with Neal McClester and Francis Lamb his security, all present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and be indebted unto the said Adam Carlyle and John Carlyle in four hundred pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their body goods and Chattells Lands and tenements jointly and severally to the use of the said Adam Carlyle and John Carlyle their heirs and assigns to be made and Levied If it happen that the said John McClester do not comply with the Law in relation to the Guardianship aforesaid and do not deliver up unto the said Adam Carlyle and John Carlyle, or their Guardian, or Guardians, if any all their estate both lease and personale, that he shall have in his hands and possession, peaceably and quietly whenever the same shall be legally required &c. —

Upon the motion of William Galsborough Clerk of the Indictments for Somerset County It is ordered by the Court that the Sheriffs of Somerset Return a panel of Grand Jurors immediately to Enquire for his Lordship and the Body of Somerset County, which Jurors are as followeth viz. Nicholas Hamblin, John Records Thomas Humphreys William Brookes James Jones Manny, Benj. Goodrich Charles Roach, Benj. Holland Neal McClester, John Shippo, Abraham Ingram Henry Toderie William Vaughan, Wm Gray John Couch Richard Hall John Mepex Robert Gowan and James Thompson John Larrimore and David Stutton Whereupon proclamation being made in usual form and the Jurors aforesaid so as aforesaid Impannelled being severally called over by their names did appear as above and there <sup>upon</sup> they were sworn and charged and sent out to Consider &c. soon after the Grand Jurors aforesaid being Impannelled sworn and charged as aforesaid Return herein to Court and being severally called over appear and return the following presentment against many Bolds thereupon the Grand Jurors aforesaid are discharged and ordered that they be allowed four hundred pounds of tobacco for their publick service this Court and against the said many Bolds so as aforesaid Presented it is ordered that Capias Issue Returnable to next Court &c. —
