One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came William Goldborough of Somerset County Gent who for his said Lordship in this part followeth and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise came and made return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following vid Regi Corpus &c. Talis welle flos

Whereupon the said Sheriff to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent. altho' solemnly called brings not in the body of the same Comfort Townsend according to the return of his writ aforesaid

At which said next Court to wit the nineteenth day of June One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came the said Comfort Townsend by Francis Allen her attorney and saith that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises contained in the Indictment aforesaid in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid above against her supposed.

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Comfort Townsend pay to his Lordship the said propriety for her fine by the Court here upon her imposed for and by reason of the premises aforesaid which of us for aforesaid she is bound thirty shillings current money to the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Comfort Townsend be taken to satis for his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid. whereupon she is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid upon Joshua Caldwell of Somerset County Gent present here in Court in his proper person acknowledged and himself indebted in five pounds Sterling to be levied &c. In case he doth not pay the severall Officers fees due by means of the premises aforesaid

John Sheldon appears according to his Recognizance for the good behaviour, and forasmuch as nothing appeared against him, to continue him bound, the said John Sheldon and his Security is discharged from the Recognizance aforesaid

His Lordship --- } John Persons of Somerset County planter came herein to Court in his proper person and pray  
John Persons } that his appearance may be recorded to save himselfe and Security <sup>from</sup> a certain Recognizance  
of Bail before Entered into for his appearance at this Court &c.

Whereupon the said John Persons appearance is recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged thereupon the said John Persons is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due upon the premises aforesaid whereupon Abraham James Smith of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the same John Persons in five pounds Sterling to be levied &c. In case he doth not pay the severall Officers their fees due by means of the premises aforesaid
