pounds of Good Sound Merchantable Leaf Tobacco which unto him he Oweth and Unjustly

And the said William Clayland by William Goldsborough his attorney declared against the said Patrick
Connally in the place as followeth vid. Somerset County vs. Patrick Connally late of Somerset

County in the province of Maryland Master otherwise called Patrick Connally of Somerset County in

Render unto him the sum or quantity of two thousand five hundred pounds of good sound merchant-

bound unto the afo William Clayland in the afo sum or quantity of Two thousand five
hundred pounds of Good Sound Merchantable Leaf Tobacco to be paid unto the same William
Clayland when thereof afterward he should be required Nevertheless the afo Patrick did
often require the afo Two thousand five hundred pounds of Good Sound Merchantable Leaf
Tobacco unto the same William Clayland hath not paid but that unto him hitherto to pay
altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same William Clayland for
Thousands pounds of like Tobacco and thereupon he bring suit here and doth bring hereinto but
the Writing Obligatory afo which the Debt afo in Form and doth Testify the Date whereof
is the same Day and Year afo &c
