in the plea afo -- At which said time Tuesday of June to Witte the Eighteenth Day of the same month  
and some One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four being the Day of the return of the said Writ  
Comitt the said William Clayland by his attorney afo. and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom  
the foregoing Writt was directed shewise comes and makes Return thereof to the Court  
here Endorsed Legi Cogus declaration in June - of Joshua Caldwell Sher. - -

Whereupon the said Patrick Connelly being present herein Court in his proper person at the prayer of the  
said William Clayland by his attorney afo is adjudged to give Speial Bail to the action afo. Thow upon a certain  
William Beavins of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person  
Undertook for the said Patrick Connelly and assumed upon himself that if in Case the said William  
Clayland should recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said Patrick Connelly or that the  
said Patrick Connelly should be therein Convict that then he the said Patrick Connelly should  
pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the custody of the Sher. of  
Somerset County in Satisfaction hereof or that he the said William Beavins will do the same  
for him &c

Whereupon the said Patrick Connelly prays that the said William Clayland may give  
Security for Costs in Case nonsuit be obtained against him in the plea afo which is by the Court granted there-  
upon William Goldsbrough of Somerset County Gent. undertakes for the said William Clayland that in Case he be  
nonsuited in the plea afo or otherwise Legally Cost that then the said William Clayland shall pay the Condem-  
nation of the Court thereupon and all Costs accruing thereon to the said Patrick Connelly or that he the  
said William Goldsbrough will do it for him &c

Whereupon the said Patrick Connelly in his own proper person comes and defends the free and  
Injury when &c and says that he cannot gain say the action afo of the afo William Clayland nor can he  
say but that the writing Obligatory afo is his deed nor can he say but that he owes the same Wm. the  
afo two thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the afo Wm. above against  
him hath declared whereupon the same William prays Judgment for his debt afo and his damages sustained  
by Quasion of the detaining of that same debt &c

Therefore it is Considered that the afo William Clayland Recover against the afo Patrick Connelly  
his debt afo and his damages by Quasion of the detaining of the same debt to some hundred & eleven  
pounds of tobacco to the same Wm. of his afo by the Court here adjudged  
and the afo Patrick Connelly in Merit &c
