Baltimore &c: To the Sher. of Somerset County Greeting we Command you that you Attach any the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Samuel Bickering late of Somerset County Murriner if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of Seven pounds Ten Shillings Curr. Money & five hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same Attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly To and for the Use of a certain Dennis Hudson Unless the said Samuel Bickering by himself or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Dennis Hudson in plea of Trespass upon the Case according to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so Attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them ^{it} shall seem Meet and how you shall execute this Writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writt Witness Robert King Esq. Chief Justice of our said Court the third Day of April in the Nineteenth Year of our Dominion &c: And Done One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four

At which said Third Tuesday of June to witt the Eighteenth Day of the same Month and Done One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four being the Day of the Return of the said Writt Cometh the said Dennis Hudson in his own proper person and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writt was Directed Likewise Comes and makes Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed By Vertue of the within Writt to me Directed to the Justices of Somerset County Court I Do Certifie that On the fourth Day of June One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four I Did Attach of the Goods and Chattels of the within Named Samuel Bickering and for the Use of Dennis Hudson to the Value of Seven pounds Ten Shillings Currant Money of Maryland and five hundred pounds of Tobacco in the hands of Archibald M. Neall I Do further Certifie that before John Doe and Richard Roe Good and Lawfull Men of my Bailiwick that he be and appear at the Time and place appointed to answer — Do said well Sher.

Whereupon the said Archibald M. Neall Garnishes of the said Samuel Bickering altho' solemnly Called Comes not but makes default &c. Thereupon the said Dennis Hudson present herein Court in his proper person prays that the sum of Seven pounds ten Shillings Curr. Money of Maryland and five hundred pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached (upon his giving security according to law) may be condemned in the hands of the said Archibald M. Neall as the Rights and Credits of the said Samuel.
