Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the Eff Sum of Seven pounds ten Shillings and
money and five hundred pounds of Tobacco so as afo attached be condemned in the hands of the afo Archi:
- bad Meneal as of the rights and Credits of the said Samuel Bickering towards Satisfying unto the said
Dennis Hudson his Damages and Costs, and that the said Dennis have them of Breunon &c.

Greeting we Command you that you Attach any the Goods Chattel Rights or Credits of Robert
Townend late of Somerset County Joyner if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value
of four pounds Curr. Money of Maryland and five hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you
have the same Attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you
have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the
third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the
use of afo Adam Spence Jnd. unless the said Robert Townend by himself or his attorney shall appear
and answer unto the said Adam Spence in plea of his plea upon the case &c. according to Law and
that by good and Law full men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the persons or persons in
whose hands you make the same attachment that ^{for} they be and appear before our Justices of
our County Court to be hold as afo to show Cause if any be for or they have why the same goods Chattels
Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Breunon thereof
had and made according to act of assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall
seem mete and how you shall extend this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the
day and place afo and have you then and then this writ Witness Robert King Gent. Chief Justice
