: taker for the said Dennis Hudson According to act of Assembly that in case the said Samuel Bickering do at  
any time within year and day appear and make all or any part of the said Dennis Hudsons claim against  
him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying of this attachment that then the  
said Dennis Hudson shall make restitution unto him the said Samuel Bickering of all or such part thereof  
as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said William Hudson will do it for him —

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the sum of Seven pounds ten shillings and  
money and five hundred pounds of tobacco so as ~~as~~ attached be condemned in the hands of the ~~Arch:~~ Archi-  
-bald menial as of the rights and credits of the said Samuel Bickering toward, Satisfying unto the said  
Dennis Hudson his damages and costs, and that the said Dennis have the same of Stenhouse ~~de~~

Adm. Adam Spence Ind. - His Lordships the Right honble the Lord Proprietary Commanded the Sheriff  
of Somerset County by his writ in these words following out — Somerset's  
Robt Connally Esq. of Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland  
And Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Somerset County  
Greeting we command you that you attack any the Goods, Chattels Right or Credits of Robert  
Townsend late of Somerset County Jorner if they shall be found in your baileywick to the Value  
offour pounds East Money of Maryland and five hundred pounds of Tobacco and where you  
have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you  
have the same before our Justice of Our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the  
next Tuesday of June Next there and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the  
use of a certain Adam Spence Ind. unless the said Robert Townsend by himself or his attorney shall appear  
and answer unto the said Adam Spence in a plea of her p[ro]p[ri]et[y] upon the case &c. according to Law and  
that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailewick you make known unto the persons or persons in  
whose hands you have the same attachment that ~~so~~ or they be and appear before our Justices of  
Our County Court to be told as ~~as~~ to show cause if any he ~~so~~ or they have why the same good, Chattells  
Rights or Credits so attached in his hand or their hands Ought not to be condemned and execution thos of  
this and made according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him for whom it shall  
seen ~~mete~~ and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the  
day and place ~~as~~ and have you them and then this writ witness Robert King Genl. Chief Justice  
of Our said Court the third day of May: and Dated One thousand seven hundred & thirty four —

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the eighteenth day of the same month and Dated One  
thousand seven hundred and thirty four being the day of the return of the said writ witness the said  
Adam Spence Ind. by Robt Dennis his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the  
foregoing writ was directed <sup>liveris</sup> and makes return thereto the first day endorsed in these words  
following —
