Damages the <sup>af</sup> John has Sustained by Breach of the Non performance of the promise and assumption <sup>of</sup> Com-  
mand is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that by the Oath of Honest and Lawfull men of his County he diligenc-  
ly Inquire what Damages the <sup>af</sup> John hath Sustained as well by Breach of the non performance of the pro-  
mise and assumption <sup>af</sup> as for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed and the Inqui-  
sition which thereupon he should take he make appear to the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somers-  
set to be hold at Diving Creek the third Tuesday of November next under his Seal, and the Seal of them  
by whose Oath the same Inquisition is taken he send together with the writ thereof to him directed and the same  
day is given to the <sup>af</sup> James Lord also &c. — And that he should then and there have the writ  
for that purpose to him to be directed but before the Issuing of the said Writ to Writ  
on the Twentieth day of August one thousand seven hundred and thirty two the said  
John at the County aforesaid died Intestate as it is said after whose death Adminis-  
tration of all and singular the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of  
the aforesaid John at the time of his Death to Sarah Stewart Widow of the aforesaid  
John to wit on the thirty first Day of August Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and  
thirty two by David Wilson Deputy Comis. of said County in Due form of Law  
was Comitted as by the Insinuation of the said Sarah we are given to Understand  
by Reason whereof and by force and Virtue of the Statute in such Case lately made  
and provided Action Accrossed to the said Sarah to prosecute the suit <sup>af</sup> and to  
have Damages thereupon ascert in order to the obtaining final Judgment and  
Execution as well for the Damages <sup>af</sup> as all Costs and Charges about the afores.  
Suit Oppoyed Thereupon it was Comitted the said Sheriff that by Honest and Lawfull  
men of his County he should make known unto the <sup>af</sup> James Lord that  
he should be and appear before our Justices of our County Court <sup>af</sup> to be hold at  
Diving Creek the third Tuesday of November next to show Cause if that any  
thing for himself he had or to say knoweth wherefore the said Sarah should not have  
her writ of Inquiry of Damages on the Recovery <sup>af</sup> according to the form  
of the Statute in such Case lately made and provided at which Day came the  
<sup>af</sup> Sarah by Francis Allen her Attorney and the said Sheriff at that same Day  
Returned to <sup>the</sup> Justices at Diving Creek <sup>af</sup> that he had made known unto  
the aforesaid James that he be and appear before the same Justices at the  
Day and place aforesaid and the said James so forewarned by William Buckingham  
his Attorney and says that he cannot Gain say but that the <sup>af</sup> Sarah ought  
to have her writ of Inquiry of Damages against the aforesaid James on the Recovery  
<sup>af</sup> according to the form of the Statute in such Case lately made and provided
