Occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption and as for her Costs and Charges by her about the Suit in that part apposed and the Inquisition which there upon he should take he made appear to his Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the County and the third Tuesday of June next under his Seal and the Seal of them by whose Oath the same Inquisition is taken he send together with the writ therof to him directed and the same day is given to the afft James Thor also Esq. At which said third Tuesday of March to witt the twentieth day of the same month anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two before his Lordships Justices of Somerset County Court then hold at Dividing Creek in the County and came the afft Sarah by her attorney affd and the same Sheriff sends not therof the writ — Therefore as before it is commanded the same Justices by the Oath of Honest and Lawfull men of this County he Diligently Enquire inform affd &c and the Inquisition which therupon he should take to his Lordships Justices of the County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the County and the third Tuesday of June next under his Seal and the Seals of them he send together with the writ to him therof directed &c and the same day is given to the same James also — At which said third Tuesday of June to witt the nineteenth day of the same month anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty three at Dividing Creek in the County affd came the afft Sarah Stewart by her attorney affd and the Sheriff to witt Joshua Caldwell gent. returned a certain Inquisition taken and Indented before him at the Court house in Somerset County at Dividing Creek on the ninth day of June instant by the Oath of Honest and Lawfull men of his County by which it appears that the afft Sarah has sustained damages by reason affd further than her Costs and Charges by her about her Suit in that part apposed to Seven pounds Eighteen shillings and nine pence three farthings Current money of Maryland for those Costs and Charges to one pound of tobacco — Therefore it is considered that the afft Sarah Stewart and of the same John Stewart Recover against the afft James Lidor her damages and by the Inquisition affd in form affd appears as also 1245. Twelve hundred and fifteen pounds of tobacco for her Costs and Charges affd to the same Sarah by the Court house of her affd sum of increase adjudged which certain damage in the whole do amount to Seven pounds Eighteen shillings and nine pence three farthings Current money of Maryland and twelve hundred and fifteen pounds of tobacco and the afft James in Maryland —

Somerset vs. William West of Somerset parish in Somerset County was summoned to Answer unto Edw: North of a plea that he Rendered unto him five pounds twelve shillings and three hundred and forty two shillings of tobacco which to him he oweth & unjustly Detaineth &c

And Whereupon the same Edw: North by George Dashfield his Attorney says — that Whereas the aforesaid Edw: North in November Court to Witt the Twenty first Day of this same Month anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty one
