Following viz. By virtue of the within writ to me directed to the Justices of Somerset County I do Certifie that on the fourteenth day of June One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four I do Certifie that I did attach of the goods and Chattell of the within named Robert Townsend in the hands of John Dennis Ind. and Patrick Conolly to the value of four pounds Curr. money of Maryland and five hundred pounds of tobacco and for the use of Adam Spence Ind. and I do further Certifie that before John Doe and Richard Roe good and Lawfull men of my balywick I have made known that they be and appear at the time and place appointed &c. so answers. For Caldwell shd.

Whereupon the said Patrick Conolly garnishes of the said Robert Townsend in his own proper person appears and Says that he cannot gainsay but that he has of the rights and Credits of the said Robert Townsend to the value of six pounds Currant money and not more nor can he say but that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the said Adam Spence Ind. as of the rights and Credits of the same Robert Townsend which the said p^lff doth not gainsay

Thereupon the said Adam Spence Ind. by his attorney sh^d prays that upon giving security according to Law the said Sum of Six pounds Currant money so as sh^d Confessed by the said Patrick Conolly as of the rights and Credits of the said Rob^t Townsend may be condemned in the hands of the said Patrick Conolly towards Satisfying unto the said Adam Spence Ind. his Damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment sh^d &c.

Whereupon Robert Jenkinis Henry of Somerset County Gents. present herein Court in his proper person undertakes for the said Adam Spence Ind. according to act of assembly that in case the said Robert Townsend do at any time within a year and aday appear and make all or any part of the said Adam Spence Ind. Claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be undue before the laying the attachment sh^d that then he the said Adam Spence shall make restitution unto him the said Robert Townsend of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said Robert Jenkinis Henry will do it for him

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the said Sum of six pounds Currant money so as sh^d Confessed be condemned in the hands of the said Patrick Conolly as of the rights and Credits of the said Robert Townsend towards Satisfying unto the said Adam Spence Ind. his Damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the writ of attachment sh^d and that the said Adam Spence Ind. have thereof his Execution &c. - Memorand^m. that John Dennis Ind. the other of the garnishes is discharged from the attachment sh^d &c.
