following Dir. By Virtue of the within writt to me directed to the Justices of Somerset County I do certifie  
that on the fourteenth day of June One thousand Seven hundred and Thirly four do certifie that I did  
attach of the goods and chattell of the within named Robert Townsend in the hands of John Dennis  
Jnd<sup>t</sup> and Gabriel Connally to the value of four pounds curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland and five hundred  
pounds of tobacco and for the use of Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> and I do further certifie that before John  
Doe and Richard Rose good and Lawfull men of my baly wch I have made knowne that they be and  
appear at the time and place apponited & so answers. Ios Goldwell Jnd<sup>t</sup>.

Whereupon the said Gabriel Connally garnishee of the said Robert Townsend in his proper  
person appear and says that he cannot gainsay but that he has of the lights and credits of the  
said Robert Townsend to the value of Six pounds current money and not more nor can he say but  
that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> as  
of the lights and credits of the same Robert Townsend which the said p<sup>t</sup> doth not gainsay.

Thereupon the said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> by his attorney &c prays that upon giving security  
according to Law the sum of Six pounds current money so as aforesaid Conceded by the said Gabriel  
Connally as of the lights and credits of the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Townsend may be condemned in the hands of  
the same Gabriel Connally towards Satisfying unto the said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> his damages and all  
Costs and charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid.

Whereupon Robert Dennis Henry of Somerset County Gent<sup>r</sup> present herein Court in his proper  
person undertakes for the said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> according to act of assembly that in case the said  
Robert Townsend do at any time within a year and aday appear and make all or any part of the said  
Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to be undue before the laying the  
attachment aforesaid that then he the said Adam Spence shall make restitution unto him the said Robert  
Townsend of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue or that he the said  
Robert Dennis Henry will do it for him.

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the sum of Six pounds curr<sup>t</sup>  
money so as aforesaid be condemned in the hands of the said Gabriel Connally as of the lights  
and credits of the said Robert Townsend towards Satisfying unto the said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> his  
damages and all costs and charges accruing by means of the writt of attachment aforesaid and that the  
said Adam Spence Jnd<sup>t</sup> have therof his execution. — Memorandum: That John Dennis and the other  
of the garnishees are discharged from the attachment aforesaid.
