here in Court in his proper person undertakes for the said Joseph Hale that if in Case the said William
Burton should recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said Joseph Hale or that the said Joseph
Hale should be thowin Court that then he the said Joseph Hale should pay the Condemnation of the

Leave thereof to Suppose Hereuntilt next Court and he hath it and the same Day is Given to the
afo William here also & Att which said Next Court to with the Eighteenth Day of June
and Done One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came againe as well the afo William
Burton as the afo Joseph Hall by their Attorneys afo and whereupon the same Joseph says that
he cannot gainsay the action afo of the afo William nor can he say but that he did assume upon himselfe in
manner and form as the afo William above against him hath Complaind and as to the damage of the same
William by him by Occasion of the premises in that part Sustained the same Joseph saith and Confesseth
that the afo William hath Sustained Damages by Occasion of the premises further than his Costs and
Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to six pounds six shillings and six pence Current
money and not more and because the afo William deny not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be
true
