One thousand seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the aforesaid Edward Harper as the ^{af} Patrick Dailey by their attorneys ^{af} and whereupon the said Patrick Dailey pray further Leave thereof to Impare hereuntoe next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the ^{af} Edward here also &c. ---

At which said next Court to witt the eighteenth day of June and Dord. One thousand seven hundred and thirty four came again as well the ^{af} Edward Harper as the ^{af} Patrick Dailey by their attorneys ^{af} and whereupon the said Patrick Dailey as before defends the force and injury when &c. and saith that he is not guilty of the premises above upon him imposed in manner and form as the ^{af} Edward Harper above against him hath complained and of this he puts himself upon the Country and the ^{af} self in like manner. ---

Thereupon it is Comanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause to come here before ^{the Justice of} Lordships County Court of Somerset now in Court sitting at ^{Widning Beck} in the County ^{af} twelve &c. by whom &c. and who neither &c. to enquire &c. because as well &c. and afterwards immediately came thereof the Jury &c. and the Jurors of that same Jury by Joshua Colewell Sheriff of the County ^{af} to this Impennelled being called came to witt Adam Spence Edward Jones John Roach Jos. Gray John White Will^m Gray ^{gent} Michael Godwin John Webb Rob^t Collier James Smith Jonathan Bouds and angells Attain for who to say the truth of the premises being duly elected tryed and sworn upon their Oath doe say that the ^{af} Patrick Dailey is guilty of the premises in manner and form as the ^{af} Edward Harper above against him hath complained and apleed damages of the said Edward by occasion of the premises ^{af} beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to nine hundred and forty one pound of tobacco and for those Costs and Charges to one pound of tobacco &c. ---

Therefore it is Considered that the ^{af} Edward Harper recover against the ^{af} Patrick Dailey the damages ^{af} by the Jurors ^{af} in form ^{af} apleed as also six hundred & some pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges ^{af} to the same Edward by the Court here of his apleed of Inrecas adjudged which certain damages in the whole do amount to ⁶⁰⁰ ^{af} in mery &c. ---
