Thereupon the said Sheriff to witt Joshua Caldwell gent. upon publick notice given sells the same John Evans unto Majr George Darke who was the bigger bidder for seven years to commence from the date of these presents In consideration of two thousand pounds of tobacco to be paid towards Satisfaction of the four fold and fees aforesaid.

Moses Chaille Jnd. Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came here into Court before
the Worshippfull Robert King Esq^r and his associates Justices of the peace Robt
Jenkins Henry gent. who for the light hontble the Lord Proprietor in this case prosecutes and gave
the same Court here to understand and be informed that Moses Chaille Jnd. late of Somerset County
manner the twenty first day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred &
thirty three in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did Commit Adultery
with a certaine Ann More of the County aforesaid Spinster and on the body of the said Ann More then and
theredid begett a bastard child against the peace of the light hontble the Lord Proprietor of this
Province his good rule and government and also against the form of the Act of Assembly in such
case made and provided where fore the said Robert Jenkins Henry prayes advisement of the
Court in the premises and that due proof of Law against the said Moses Chaille Jnd. may stand.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he shoud take the said
Moses Chaille Jnd. if he to answer him and afterward to witt the twenty first day of August One thous
and Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset
now here held at Dividing Creek came the aforesaid Moses Chaille Jnd. by Francis Allen his attorney &
had a hearing of the Information aforesaid and says that he is not thereof guilty and of this he
putteth himself upon the Country and Robert Jenkins Henry gent. attorney of the Lord Pro-
prietor and who for the said Lord Proprietor in that part followeth likewise the

Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he shoud
cause to come here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held
at Dividing Creek in the County aforesaid twelve &c. by whom &c. and who neither he to recognize he be-
