

June Court ---- 1794 ---- 175

Here before his Lordships Justices of his County Court of Somerset now held at Widewell Creek in
the County aforesaid, to wit the Eighteenth day of June and Dated One thousand Seven hundred
and thirty four before the Justices of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset now held at Widewell
Creek aforesaid came the said Sheriff to wit Joshua Redwell Esq. and made return that he had summoned
the said Thomas Fletcher as aforesaid he was commanded whereupon afterwards immediately.
Came here into Court as well the said Thomas Johnson the petitioner as the said Thomas Fletcher in their
proper persons and the petition aforesaid being read and heard and the several allegations as well on the
part of the said Thomas Fletcher as on the part of the petitioner, and likewise the said Thomas Fletcher
making it appear to the Court here that the said Thomas Johnson had runaway from him and absented himself out of his
service sixteen days and likewise that he had paid One hundred pounds of tobacco for his taking him
up when runaway as aforesaid, and prays that the said Thomas Johnson may be adjudged to serve him for
the same runaway time and to have paid as aforesaid. Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here
that the said Thomas Johnson serve the said Thomas Fletcher his heirs or assigns twenty eight days to
commence after the twenty first day of this instant, which is adjudged full satisfaction for the runaway
time and tobacco paid as aforesaid, with what time he had already served over and above his indentured
time. Likewise the said Thomas Fletcher is adjudged to pay unto the said Thomas Johnson his
freedom due as by Law allowed him as by the petitioner aforesaid is prayed —

to William Sawyer Robert Laws and John Waller all of Somerset County in the province aforesaid are
Orphans --- holden and firmly bound unto William Sawyer Bridget Sawyer Ann Sawyer Alice
Sawyer and Benjamin Sawyer Orphans of William Sawyer decd. in the full and just sum
of nineteen pounds seventeen shillings current money of Maryland to be paid unto the said Wm.
Sawyer Bridget Sawyer Ann Sawyer Alice Sawyer and Benjamin Sawyer their heirs executors admrs
or assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves and
either of our heirs executors or administrators for the whole and unto the whole loyally and severally
firmly by these presents sealed with our Seal and dated this thirteenth day of April anno
Dom: 1794 —

The condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the Comptroller General hath trans-
mitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of William Sawyer decd. wherein it is found that there
is balance due to the abovesaid Orphans the sum of nine pounds eighteen shillings and six pence —

If therefore the abovesaid Alice Sawyer her heirs executors or administrators shall and do
well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named William Sawyer Bridget Sawyer
Ann Sawyer Alice Sawyer and Benjamin Sawyer the aforesaid sum of nine pounds eighteen shillings
and
