new possession called Turners Hale containing two hundred acres and your petitioner as in

It is considered by the Justices here that a Commission I give to the afo Thomas Bowden as by  
his petition afo is praide, and that John Holland, John Tub John Tringle and Thomas Berdus of Som-  
erset County Gent be Commissioners and Create the same Commission according to Law &c.
