The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Richard Benewell be Levy free this year as by the petition aforesaid is prayed for --

Debtors of Solomon Tule and William Wharton humbly sheweth --

That your petitioners are oppressed by the course of a road that runneth thro' their Lands also makes this Road crooked and inconvenient to be travayled the road is now marked by direction of the Overseer where we pray it may stand being from the Beach and going to the Cuttermore End of Mr William Water's now fence being amore straight and short way for the said Road and the relief of your petitioners who as in duty bound shall pray --

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation had upon had wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Solomon Tule and William Wharton turn the road as aforesaid is prayed by first cutting on the aforesaid new road back one hundred and forty yards of ditch three foot wide on the top two foot deep and two foot wide in the bottom and to spread the bank of the ditch and the old road to continue and remain unstoped until an order of Court obtained for the same for --
