the *es* John Beachamp or his Guardian to be by him Chosen all his estate Real and personall that he shall have in his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be Legally required &c.

Joseph Cockett son of Sampson Cockett dec^d is of his own free Consent bound by the Court here unto Thomas Tyler until he arrives at the age of sixteen by One Year the said Joseph Cockett being twelve Years of age the Nineteenth Day of May Last the said Joseph Cockett to serve his said Master the full term *es*, during which term the said Joseph Cockett his said Master well and faithfully shall serve his secrets keep his commandments lawfully and honestly every where willing shall do and in all things as a good and faithfull servant shall demean himself towards his said Master and all in during the term *es*. In consideration of which service the said Thomas Tyler present here in Court in his proper person Covenanteth with the Duties of the same Court Judicially sitting in manner and form following that is to say that he the said Thomas Tyler during the term *es* will learn his said apprentice to Read write & Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive, and the Trade of a Weaver and at the Expiration of his Servitude give him a new Suit of Cloaths over and above his Common wearing Cloaths & Likewise provide for his said apprentice meet Drink washing Lodging and Cloathing mete for such an apprentice to have and wear during his servitude *es*.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the *es* Thomas Tyler give security for to comply with the Covenant *es*. Thereupon the said Thomas Tyler with Arthur Barker of Somerset County planter his security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto the said Joseph Cockett in thirty pounds Sterling each of their Bodies goods or Chattells Land or tenements Separately to be made and Levied to the Use of the said Joseph Cockett his heirs or assigns If it happen that the said Thomas Tyler do not during the term *es* learn his said apprentice to Read write and Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive and the Trade of a Weaver, and do not at the Expiration of his Servitude give him a new Suit of Cloaths over and above his Common wearing Cloaths and do not Likewise provide for his said apprentice meet Drink washing Lodging and Cloathing mete for such an apprentice to have and wear during his servitude *es*.
