Baronial Council do not make his personal appearance from day to Day and every day of this  
term and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and do depart this Court without

out leave hereof and is not in the mean time of his good behaviour &c

And afterwards it was made appear to the satisfaction of the Court here that the said Bar-  
onial Council was not guilty of forgery in such manner and form as aforesaid alleged —

Whereupon the said Baronial Council and his security are discharged from the long sueteance aforesaid

George Osten } George Osten son of Joseph Osten late of Somerset County deceased is of his own-  
bound to .. } free and voluntary consent bound an apprentice by the Court unto John Sirman John  
John Sirman. Sirman of the County aforesaid Joiner until he the said George Osten arrives at the age  
of Twenty One years the said Geo: Osten being thirteen years of age next June, the said Geo: Osten  
to serve his said Master the full term of time aforesaid during which term the said George Osten his said  
Master well and faithfully shall serve his servent keeps his commandments lawfully and honestly  
every where willingly shall do and in all things as a good and faithful servant shall demean  
himself towards his said Master and all his during this term aforesaid

In consideration of which service the said John Sirman present here in Court in his proper  
person covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court, in Court judicially sitting in manner  
and form following that is to say that he the said John Sirman during the term aforesaid will learn his  
said apprentice the trade of a carpenter and Joiner, and likewise provide for his said  
apprentice during his servitude meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing ~~meat drink~~ sufficient  
for such an apprentice to have and wear &c.

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that the said John Sirman give security for  
to comply with the covenants aforesaid — Thereupon the said John Sirman with his  
Gillis of Somerset County bound his security both present herein Court with other proper  
persons and acknowledged themselves indebted unto the said Geo: Osten in twenty pounds  
Sterling of their body goods or Chattels Land or tenements severally to be made and Sealed  
to the use of the said Geo: Osten his heirs or assigns If it happen that the said John  
Sirman do not during the term aforesaid learn his said apprentice the trade of a carpenter &  
Joiner and likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging  
Clothing meat for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c.
