Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that he was Presente when the Pine or Pine Stump
Standing in y^e fork of the Branches of the head of Monahans River a Little above the bridge
where a cedar post is now fixt in the Root thereof by Consent of Henry Dorman Jas.
John Finch was Proved by White John Brown and William Heath the Brother of this deponent
and severale others Evidence to be the first Bounder of a Tract of Land called Deep Pattenred by
John Shigway and further this Deponent saith he saw the pine before a Mailed Tree offour
Sides and that the said Tree was always Deemed and Taken to be the first Bounder of the Land aff-
called Deep this Deponent further saith that he has often Seen and heard his Mother Ursley Heath
Came a light to the plantation called Manlove Discovery where John Mulrain lived a
tenant theron Under Samuel Worthington in Right of the children to whom the Land called
Deep was Bequeathed by John Shigway Will and that this Deponent has Seen his Mother
Ursley Heath aforesd when the aforesd Tenant lived on Manlove Discovery Under Samuel
Worthington call up Hogs many a time and pullldown the Orchard fence and Turn them in
before the face of the Tenant aforesd John Mulrain or his family and the said Deponent
further saith that at the Time the above Mentioned Pine was Proved to be the first
Bounder of Deep before a Jury called therefor that Burgoes the first course of Deep was
Run from the Pine aforesd According to Pattenred by Order of the Jury the course and Distance
there Mentioned And the Surveyor to wit God Whettington after the Number of One hundred
and fifty perches was Run Out Run the Rest of the Lines as he thought fit himself
without taking any further Directions from the Jury and further this Deponent saith Not
