called Hickory ridge humbly pray your worshipps to appoint Commissioners to examine  
evidences in relation to the boundaries of the same and as in duty bound shall ever pray  
the petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood Wherefore it is considered by  
the Court here that a Commission issue to the aforesaid William Nelson as by the petition aforesaid is  
prayed and that Alexander Sachey Day Scott Joseph Wails and Charles Ballard all of  
Somerset County Gentlemen be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to  
act of assembly in such case provided &c.

His Lordship } Whereas a certain Jane Gore wife of Richard Gore came here into Court and  
Robert Gedder ... made complaint against a certain Robert Gedder that he had beat and abused  
her contrary thereto whereupon it is ordered that the Sheriff of Somerset County bring  
the said Robert Gedder here into Court immediately to answer thereto  
afterwards immediately came here into Court the said Robert Gedder in his proper person and there-  
upon the said Robert Gedder is ordered to give security for his good behaviour and appearance  
at November Court next to answer the premises &c.

Thereupon the said Robert Gedder with Francis Allen of Somerset County Gentleman both pre-  
sent here in Court in their proper person acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the right howle  
the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their severall goods and chattells Lands  
and tenements for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors to be made and levied if  
it happen that the said Robert Gedder do not make his personal appearance before the Justices  
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Widning Park the third Tuesday of Novem-  
ber next and do not answer unto his Lordship of and concerning what should be objected against him  
on his said Lordships Behalfe in relation to the premises &c and do not depart the same Court  
without leave thereof and if he is not in the meantime of his good behaviour to see his Lordships  
good people and more especially to his said Jane Gore &c

His Lordship } Likewise it is by the Court here ordered that the said Jane Gore give security for  
Jane Gore ... her appearance at November Court next to give evidence on behalf of his Lordship
