Thomas Larrimore Junr. is to answer & afterwards to wit the twentieth day of August and Doin One thousand seven hundred and thirty four before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Dividing Creek in the same County came the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. in his proper person according to a certain recognizance by him and his security in that part first acknowledged and had a hearing of the Indictment against him and says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he puts himself upon the Country and William Goldborough Gent. attorney of his Lordships and who for his said Lordships in that part followeth Likewise

whereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause to come here before the said Justices twelve or by whom & who neither to recognize because as well and afterwards immediately came before the Justices and the Jurors of that same Jury by Joseph M. Clerk Gent. Sheriff of the County to him impannelled being called came to wit, Joshua Caldwell Robert Middlehole Jonathan Bound John Whitepurnoke Ralph Milbourn Angello Alkinson, Jacob Adams Joseph Houston Philip Quinn John Alkinson Robert Jones and Robert Keirn who to say the truth of and upon the premises of being elected tried and sworn upon their Oath did say that the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. is guilty of the premises in the Indictment of specified in manner and form as by the Indictment of above against him supposed &c.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood it is considered that the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for and by occasion of the premises of which in form as he is convict thirty shillings current money for the use of the County of and that the same Thomas Larrimore Junr. be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine of &c. whereupon the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. is ordered to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises of thereupon certain John Larrimore of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. and acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling to be levied of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of the Officers that hath any fees due upon the Indictment by means of the premises of to be made and levied if it happen that the said John Larrimore do not pay unto the several Officers their fees due by means of the premises of upon the Indictment of &c.

Likewise the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. is ordered by the Court here for to save and to keep harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Sureties for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the same County from all Costs Charges and troubles by reason of the birth maintainance nourishing and bringing up of a said Child lately begott on the body of a certain Alice Hopkins &c. hereupon the said Thomas Larrimore Junr. with John Larrimore of Somerset County planter both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of
