Lord Proprietary in the sum of twenty pounds sterling each of their goods and Chattell Lands and tenements to the use of Somerset County to be severally made and Levied if it happen that the said Thomas Lammore Junr. do not from time to time and at all times here after acquitted discharged and save himself as well the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the same County of and from all last Charges troubles and burthens whatsoever for by reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and bringing up of his said Children and from all such troubles Charges and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same &c.

Alice Hopkins appears according to her Recognizance Entered into to give Evidence against Thomas Lammore Junr. & is discharged therefrom &c.

Aaron Lynn appears according to his Recognizance for good behaviour and is discharged therefrom &c.

Somerset County ff. Be it remembered that William Goldborough Gent Attorney of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is who for the same Lord Proprietary in this part prosecuteth doth come here into the County Court of the same Lord Proprietary held for Somerset County aff. to witt at Dwidning Creek in the County aff. the twentieth day of August in the Year of Our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty and four before Robert King Esq. & his Associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the same Justices hereto understand and be informed that Henry Barrett late of Somerset Parish in the County aff. planter the third Day of July in the year of Our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty and four aff. at the Parish aff. in the County within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Charity Parish of the same County squire in the peace of God and of the same Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and Arm an Assault did make and the same Charity then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of her life it was greatly disquaird and other harm to her then and there did to the great damage of the same Charity and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government &c. whereupon the same Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth the Advice of the Court herein the premises and that due process of Law in this part against the said Henry may be made to answer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Henry Barrett if he to answer &c. and afterwards to witt the twentieth day of August and Dom One thousand seven hundred and thirty four before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset now here held at Dwidning Creek in the County aff. came the said Henry Barrett in his proper person and had a hearing of the information aff. and say that of the premise aff. above upon him Imposed he is Guilty thereof and is willing to pay his fine for the fact aff. &c. whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood

It is Considered by the Court here that the said Henry Barrett pay to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon him Imposed for and by reason of the trespass and assault aff. whereof in form aff. he is Convict fifty pounds of tobacco and that the same Henry Barrett
