And whereupon the same John Reddish by Francis Allen his attorney complaineth
that whereas the aforesaid John Gafford the seventh day of November in the year of our Lord God one thousand
Seven hundred and thirty three at Somerset County and within the jurisdiction of this Court
was Indebted unto the aforesaid John Reddish in the sum of Eight pounds one shilling and four pence
currant money of Maryland for divers goods wares and merchandises by the same John Reddish unto
the aforesaid John Gafford at the Special Instance and request of the same John Gafford before that time
there sold and delivered as by an account thereof here in Court ready to be produced may appear
and so thereof being Indebted the aforesaid John Gafford afterwards to wit the same Seventh day of November
in the year aforesaid at the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction aforesaid in Consideration thereof upon
himself did assume and unto the aforesaid John Reddish then and there faithfully did promise that
he the aforesaid John Gafford the same Eight pounds one shilling and four pence unto the same
John Reddish when thereofterward he should be required well and faithfully would pay
and Content and altho the aforesaid John Gafford twelve Shillings and eight pence currant money
to the said John Reddish he hath paid and satisfied yet as to even pounds eight Shillings and
Eight pence currant money residue of the aforesaid Eight pounds one shilling and four pence the said
John Reddish his promise and Assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made but little regarding but
minding fraudulently intending the same John Gafford in this part craftily & subtilly
to deceive and defraud the aforesaid Seven pounds eight shillings and eight pence or any part
thereof unto the same John Reddish hath not paid or many stt contented altho to do the
same the aforesaid John Gafford afterward to wit the same day and year aforesaid and often afterward
at the County aforesaid within the jurisdiction aforesaid by the aforesaid John Reddish was requested but that
unto him hitherto pay or in any sort to Content altogether hath refused and Still doth
refuse to the damage of the said John Reddish of fourteen pounds Seventeen Shillings
and four pence all the money and thereupon he bringeth suit &c.
