Errors Excepted of John Reddish

Whereupon the said John Crafford in his own proper person Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when & and Saith that he cannot give say the action aforesaid of the aforesaid John Reddish nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid John Reddish

above against him hath Complaind and as to the Damage of the same John Reddish by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same John Crafford saith and Confesseth that the aforesaid John Reddish hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to Seven pounds eight Shillings and eight pence Current money of Maryland and not more and because the aforesaid John Reddish denyeth this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true prays Judgm<sup>t</sup> for those damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges a<sup>d</sup> to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties a<sup>d</sup> it is Considered that the aforesaid John Reddish recover against the aforesaid John Crafford his damages a<sup>d</sup> to the aforesaid Seven pounds eight Shillings and eight pence <sup>Current money of Maryland</sup> in form a<sup>d</sup> Confesseth as also three hundred & Twenty five pounds of Tobacco for his costs and charges a<sup>d</sup> to the same John Reddish by the Court here and consent of the parties a<sup>d</sup> adjudged and the aforesaid John Crafford in mercy &c

A Thomas Gray Somerset County's Alexander Graies late of Somerset County planter was Attached to answer unto Thomas Gray of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c And whereupon the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas by Francis Allen his Attorney Complaineth that whereas the said Alexander the second day of September seventeen hundred and thirty two at Somerset County afores<sup>d</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas in three pounds One shilling & nine pence Curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland for sundry properly Chargeables in Acc<sup>t</sup> as by Acc<sup>t</sup> thereof hereunto Annexed may in Court appear and being soe thereof Indebted the said Alexander in Consideration thereof the day and year afores<sup>d</sup> at the place afores<sup>d</sup> upon himself did Assume and to the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas then and there did faithfully promise that he the s<sup>d</sup> Alexander the afores<sup>d</sup> three pounds One shilling and nine pence to the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas when he should be afterwards thereunto requested he would well & faithfully pay and Content nevertheless the s<sup>d</sup> Alexander his promise and Assumption afores<sup>d</sup> in form a<sup>d</sup> made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently <sup>Intending</sup> the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas in that part craftily and Subtly
