And the said Alexander Chaine by George Douglas his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and prays Leave thereof to be imparke here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the s^r. Thomas Gray here also &c.

All which said next Court to witt Eighteenth day of June and Dow One thousand seven hundred and thirty four came againe as well the s^r. Thomas Gray as the s^r. Alexander Chaine by their attorneys afores^d and thereupon the said James Furni bail of the s^r. Alex^r. deliver up unto the Sheriff of Somerset County the s^r. Alexander Chaine in discharge of his Bail afores^d. the Sheriff to witt Joshua Cole well haunts present herein Court took Charge of the said Alex^r. accordingly &c.
