It was w^t Thomas Fletcher Command was given to the Sherif of Somerset County that he shoulde
take Thomas Newbold late of somerset County planter if he shoulde
be found in his bailewick and him shoulde safe keep so that he might
have his body before the Justices of his Lordship County Court of Somerset
to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next to answer unto Thomas Fletcher
of a plea of trespass upon the said &c and that thereof he shoulde not fail &c

And the said Thomas Fletcher by Francis Allen his Attorney Complains against the said
Thomas Newbold in the plea aforesaid as followeth videlicet

Somerset ss. Thomas Newbold late of Somerset County planter was attached to
Answer unto Thomas Fletcher of a plea of trespass upon the case &c

And whereupon the s^d Thomas Fletcher by Francis Allen his Attorney Complains that
whereas the s^d Thomas Newbold after the first day of May, Seventeen hundred and six
to wit on the ninth day of July, Seventeen hundred and thirty two ab Somerset County within
the Jurisdiction of this Court made a certain note in writing called a promissory note with
his proper hand Subscribed bearing date the same day and year last mentioned and the same
note to the s^d Thomas Fletcher then and there delivered by which s^d note the s^d Thomas
Newbold did promise to pay to the s^d Thomas Fletcher four thousand pounds of bound
Merchandiseable leaf Tobacco and Eighty p^t Cent Interest for the same in cash within a year and a
day of the date of the s^d note and by reason thereof as also by force of the Statute in that
case lately made and provided the s^d Thomas Newbold became Chargeable to pay to the s^d
Thomas Fletcher the s^d sum of Tobacco and Interest at Eighty Cent in cash according to
the tenor of the s^d note and being Chargeable the s^d Thomas Newbold in Consideration
thereof afterwards to wit the 1st ninth day of July Ann^d Dom^d Seventeen hundred and
thirty two as upon himself did assume and to the s^d Thomas Fletcher then and there did
faithfully promise that he the s^d Thomas Newbold the s^d sum of Tobacco and Interest at
Eighty p^t Cent in cash according to the tenor of the s^d note to the s^d Thomas Fletcher when
he should be thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content. Nevertheless
the s^d Thomas Newbold his promise and Assumption as in form as made nothing regard-
ing but plotting and fraudulently Intending the s^d Thomas Fletcher in that part Craftily
and Subtilly to deceive and defraud the s^d four thousand pounds of Tobacco and Eighty p^t
Cent Interest for the same within a year and a day of the date of the s^d note to the s^d Thomas
Fletcher tho often thereunto requested hath not paid or Contented but the same to him
hitherto to pay hath refused and still doth refuse and deny to the damage of the said
Thomas Fletcher of eight thousand pounds of tobacco And thereupon he brings in suit &c.

writ came the said Thomas Fletcher by his Attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somer-
set County to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise came and made return thereof to
the Court here in these words Endowed Capi Corpus declaration in time delivered &
