And the afd Thomas Lambert by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when &c; and says that he cannot gainsay the action afd ^{of the afd John Reader} nor can he say but that the writing obligatory afd is the deed of the same Thomas nor but that he owes the same John Reader the afd forty four pounds in gold or silver money of Maryland in manner and form as the afd John Reader above against him hath declared wherefore the said plaintiff prays Judgment for his debt afd and the damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of that same debt to him to be adjudged &c;

Therefore it is considered that the afd John Reader Recover against the afd Thomas Lambert his debt afd and his damages by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to three hundred & Two ³⁰² pounds of tobacco to the same John of his afd by the Court here adjudged and the afd Thomas in mercy &c;

Bolton the afd one hundred and fifty three pounds six shillings lawfull money of America in manner and form as the afd Robert Bolton above against him hath declared wherefore the said plaintiff prays Judgment for his debt afd and his damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of that same debt to him to be adjudged &c;

Therefore it is considered that the afd Robert Bolton Recover against the afd Edward Rownd his debt afd and his damages by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to Two hundred ⁹⁷⁷ & Seventy Seven pounds of tobacco to the same Robert of his afd by the Court here adjudged and the afd Edward in mercy &c;
