Robert herealso e. At which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of August
And Dated One thousand seven hundred and thirty four came again as well the afo Robert Nairn
as the afo James Nairn by their Attorneys afo and whereupon the same James Nairn as before
defends the force & Injury whereto and saith that he doth not detain the afo Copper Brandy still
and peyster worm and one pair of Cullen Millstones in manner and form as the said Robert
above against him hath complained and of this he put himself upon the County e.
and the p[ro]f[ess]it is like manner — Thereupon it is commanded the sherriff of
Somerset County that immediately he should cause to come here before the Justices of his Lordships County
Court of Somerset now sitting at Dividing Creek in the County at Twelve &c by whom it is who ne
there to recognize it because as well it is and afterward immediately came here of the Jury &c and the
Jury of that same Jury by Joseph Muggester Gent. Sheriff of the County to this impanelled being
came to witt John Dowdton Robert Mitchell Jonathan Bownds John Webb Geo: Benson Ralph Mill
Angelo Atkinson Jacob Adams Joseph Houston Philip Quinton John Atkinson and Samuel Roach
who to say his bulk of his premises afo being duly elected tried and Sworn upon their Oath do
say that the afo James does detain from the afo Robert the afo Copper Brandy Still and Pewter
worm and one pair of Cullen Millstones in manner and form as the afo Robert above against him
hath complained and further say upon their Oath that the afo Copper Brandy Still & peyster worm
are of the value of fifteen pounds current money of Maryland and that the afo Cullen millstones
are of the value of forty Shillings current money of Maryland and the same Juries apposed the
damages of the same Robert by occasion of his premises further than his costs and charges by
him about his suit in that part apposed to six pence and for those costs and charges to one
pound of tobacco Therefore it is considered that the afo Robert Nairn Recover against
the afo James Nairn the afo Copper Brandy Still and Pewter worm and one pair of Cullen
Millstones or the afo Seventeen pounds current money of Maryland for value of the same
if the same Robert the afo Copper Brandy Still and Pewter worm and one pair of Cullen
Millstones cannot have again also his damages afo by his Juries afo in sum afo apposed as
also twelve hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges at his request
by the court last of June adjudged which certain damages in the whole do amount to Seven
hundred and six pounds current money of Maryland & twelve hundred eighty two pounds of tobacco in value
