County Merch: if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of One hundred and three pounds
fifteen shillings and two pence Curr. money & two thousand pounds of tobacco and when you have the
same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same
before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the Third Tuesday
of March Next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of
aertain Robert Bolton Unless the said Robert Holland by himself or his Attorney shall appear
and answer unto the said Robert Bolton in a plea of trespass upon the Case & according to Law and
that by good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons
in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our
Justices of our County Court to be held as afo to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the
same Goods Chattels Right or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned
and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided
if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make
known unto our said Justices at the day and place afo and have you then and there this writ

further Certifie that before Joshua Merrill and Richard Roe Good and Lawfull men of my
bailiwick I have made known to the afores. Samuel Hopkins Ind. and William Lord Ind. that they
